REVA University Statutes Governing Energy Management Policy, 2017

The Vice Chancellor explained before the members of the Board of Governors that energy is an

important resource which needs to be consumed economically. There are different varieties of

energy sources today we use in our houses and institutions. There is also a need to generate

energy using alternate energy sources. To inculcate among the REVA family members the culture

of energy saving and also involve in energy resource development, it is felt necessary to frame a

Statute governing energy policy. Hence a draft REVA University Statutes Governing Energy

Management Policy, 2017 was prepared and placed before the Academic Council. All members

of the Academic Council unanimously approved the draft statute. The said draft statute along with

the decision of the Academic Council was placed before the Board of Management and all the

members of the BOM have unanimously approved the said statute. Hence the draft "REVA

University Statutes Governing Energy Management Policy, 2017" attached in the given

Annexure below is placed before the August house for consideration and decision.

Decision: All the members noted the proposed intake of the students, discussed in detail about the market demand and unanimously approved the proposed program wise intake of the students mentioned against each of the 38 programs for the year 2017-18.

a. Introduction of Diploma in Plumbing, Diploma in Electric Maintenance and Diploma in Electronic Equipment repair and maintenance:

Hon'ble Chancellor Sir appraising about skill development programs undertaken by the University, said that the university is trying to introduce more and more certificate diploma and PG diploma programs particularly those that facilitate unemployed youth to secure jobs. One of such diploma course being initiated now is Diploma in Plumbing. We understand there are many institutions including hotel industry and educational institutions want plumbers for maintenance work. This diploma will help unemployed youth to secure jobs in such sectors. Likewise we would also initiate diploma programs in Electric maintenance, repair and maintenance of electronic equipments and so on. Hon'ble member Shri. Satyananda Mishra said such courses are very much required even in hospitals. The university may in joint collaboration introduce hospital management, heath management and such other short term courses to facilitate employment to unemployed youth and as well as the students studying in REVA University.

Decision:

The august house unanimously resolved to introduce diploma in plumbing, diploma in electric maintenance, diploma in electronic equipment repairs and maintenance courses in REVA University.

b. Nomination of two persons for formation of nomination committee for appointment of Vice-Chancellor

The Vice-Chancellor explained before the august house that as per the Section 16(1) of the REVA University Act 2012, the term of the Vice-Chancellor is for a period of three years, extendable by one more year. For the appointment of the Vice-Chancellor a nomination committee comprising of three persons has to be constituted and the Board of Governors has to nominate two members of whom one shall be convenor of the committee. Present Vice-Chancellor is completing four years shortly. Therefore a nomination committee has to be constituted for appointment of the Vice-Chancellor and the Board of the Governors has to nominate two persons on the nomination Committee. He proposed Prof. K.Chidananda Gowda, former Vice-Chancellor of Kuvempu University and presently a member of the REVA University Board of Governors nominated by the Government of Karnataka. He also proposed Prof. K Siddappa, Former Vice-Chancellor of Bangalore University as one more member.

Decision:

The august house unanimously decided to nominate Prof. K Chidananda Gowda, former Vice-Chancellor of Kuvempu University and Prof. K Siddappa, Former Vice-Chancellor of Bangalore University as members of the nomination committee for selection of Vice-Chancellor. The house also decided to nominate Prof. K Chidananda Gowda as the Convenor of the Nomination Committee.

At the end Registrar thanked all the members for their continous advise, support and cooperation for the development of the University. The meeting was then concluded.
