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






3. Setting of Question Papers

The list of paper setter along with the course handouts and the patterns of question papers is submitted to the Registrar (Evaluation) by the Directors of the respective Schools. At least two sets of question papers are prepared by the paper setter(s). The questions are framed in a way that the Student Learning Outcomes of the course are adequately assessed. The weightage given to each module of instruction is properly reflected in questions. The question papers have different formats depending upon the nature of the course subject. The quality check of the question paper is done by the subject experts for which list is provided by the respective Director. The Registrar (Evaluation) selects the question papers for the exam. The Assistant Registrar (Evaluation) along with officials nominated by the Registrar (Evaluation) then prints the question papers at a secured venue of examinations department. The questions papers are sealed in the envelope and are kept secure in the strong room's almirah with a double lock at the examination center in the presence of an observer. One key remains in possession of Registrar (Evaluation) and the other with Assistant Registrar (Evaluation).

Preamble: The Semester End Examinations (SEE) of II, IV, VI, VIII, X semesters of various programmes that come under different faculties of REVA University are scheduled during the months of May and June 2020. The SEEs conducted will have certain deviations in the mode of conduct of examinations, pattern of question papers and overall weightage distribution between continuous assessments and SEE from the University Examination Regulations due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

UGC Guidelines on Examinations:

One may refer "UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for the Universities in View of COVID-19 Pandemic and Subsequent Lockdown", D.O.No. F. 1-1/2020(Secy) dated 29th April 2020.

As per the guidelines, REVA University has decided to conduct Semester End Examinations (SEE) through online mode, using Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) pattern of question paper. Each such examination will be held for a duration of 2 hours and for a maximum of 60 marks. The weightage distribution for deciding grade in each course is 70% for continuous assessment (assessed through assignments, quizzes, tests) and 30% for SEE conducted online.

The online examination will be administered through a Third Party who has expertise in conducting online examinations to various corporates and Universities.

Online Examination Guidelines for Students:

Online examinations are scheduled from 27th of May 2020.

Students will receive an email with the final exam link from admin@mettl.com on their REVA Email ID.

Instructions regarding online examinations:

Note:

i) Class teachers will inform all students about the dates of their practical exams, assignment dates and viva-voce and MRP viva-voce immediately. They will also inform them about the time frame of the theory exam, the detailed timetable of which will be intimated after we receive it from RE's office.

ii) Class teachers will inform students to pay their course fees and exam fees and convocation fees (wherever applicable) immediately.

iii) Class teachers, with the help of mentors, will counsel and give comfort to every student about the conduct of online exam based on the need of the hour. Every student and her/ his problem is important. v) Viva-voce will be conducted through MS Teams and during their viva-voce, video will be enabled for the students.

5. Malpractice & Lapses Enquiry Committee (MPLEC)

The student using any unfair means while writing their exams are reported to the Registrar (Evaluation) by the Centre Superintendent after conducting examinations. The unfair mean case committee is constituted by the Registrar (Evaluation) with due approval from the Vice- Chancellor. The decisions of the MPLEC committee are forwarded through the Registrar (Evaluation) to the Vice- Chancellor for approval.

Due to pandemic semester end examination was conducted online mode with MCQs.

6. Central Evaluation

The evaluation is conducted centrally under the supervision of the Assistant Registrar (Evaluation). The solution of question papers provided by experts are submitted to the office of Registrar (Evaluation) before the beginning of the evaluation. The coded answer books handed over to the evaluators. The appropriate number of Evaluators/Reviewers/Checking Assistants is deputed during evaluations. The award lists along with answer books are submitted to the evaluation section.

Due to pandemic semester end examination was conducted online mode with MCQs.

7. Declaration of Result

Marks scored by the students in their IA as well as in SEE in all the courses of a given semester must be tabulated into the software installed for the purpose by the University. The same must be done for all the semesters of UG and PG within the Specified date by the Registrar (Evaluation).

The Registrar (Evaluation) will announce the results of the students in each semester on the Faculty notice board as well as on the University website after Director of School confirms about the result to Registrar (Evaluation).

8. Revaluation

After declaration of the results of programs within next 10 days, if any candidate wishes to apply for Photocopy/Revaluation (only theory courses), s/he shall apply to the Registrar (Evaluation), by paying the prescribed fees notified by the University from time to time. The photocopies of the said answer books shall be made available within next TEN working days after the last date prescribed for receipt of the application at the Office of the Registrar (Evaluation). Photocopies will not be issued for practical/drawing/audit courses.

Due to pandemic semester end examination (even semester) was conducted online mode with MCQs. During 2019-20 examination **total of 243** applications were received for Revaluation and resolved.

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9. Award of Degree

Degree is awarded at the end of the completion of the Program and accumulation of specified number of credits for the given program. Students are issued-Grade Cards/Marks card for each semester, consolidated grade Card/Marks card and degree Certificate. Such of those students who have accumulated credits by studying in more than one university, but finally completing their degree at REVA University by accumulating the required number of credits, will be issued grade cards for suchof the courses completed at REVA University and a transcript by mentioning as 'credit transferred from other university' against the credits earned. Students are required to possess all the grade cards issued by different institutions as a proof to the accumulation of Credits.

Award of Gold Medal Guidelines

- The candidate with highest CGPA will be awarded gold medal. The University shall issue the certificate indicating the name of the medal awarded to the students
- If two or more students have secured the same CGPA, then the marks secured by the student in the external examination only shall be taken in consideration in awarding the gold medalist.
- If both students also secure to the same external marks then both the students should be awarded the gold medal.
- A student who has been fined or expelled from the hostel/university for any act of indiscipline shall not be eligible for the award of gold medal(s). A student who has failed in any course and has cleared the course in the repeat examination shall not be eligible for award for gold medals/certificate.
