## **Policy on Ethical practices**

REVA UNIVERSITY considers the following practices as unethical and views them seriously

- Plagiarizing someone's results or contents of articles without duly
- · acknowledging the source
- · Duplicating results and claiming them as original contributions and
- Submitting the same research article to different journals
- Giving authorship to someone who has not made any contribution, in return for a favor
- Using the results, confidential data from an article that is being reviewed for personal benefits
- Being biased as a reviewer/Guide
- Not presenting the actual outcomes of the funded project/ research investigation
- Expecting favors/gifts from research scholars in return for undeserved recommendations
- Not giving due credits to people who have contributed to the project/research articles
- Making derogatory comments and personal attacks against scholars and Not providing constructive feedbacks on scholar's work during progress review meetings
- Exposing scholars/students to hazardous conditions.
- In order to limit the similarity contents in research articles and theses, the following regulations shall apply:
- All the faculty members and students are encouraged to check the plagiarism
  of their research paper and research proposal before submitting to any journal/
  conference/funding agency. Permission is granted only if the similarity index is
  10% or below.
- All the seed money proposals shall be subjected to plagiarism using the licensed software turnitin
