

Awareness program-2018



At School of EEE, 6th sem students have conducted awareness program on energy conservation and renewable energy system for the rural village people at the Shivakote village near Hesaragatta, rural Bangalore on 24-03-2018. About 110 students and 5 faculties have participated in the awareness program. During this program, the students have visited all the houses in the village to conduct door to door survey and collected the energy details from each house: The students explained about the energy conservation measures that can be adopted to reduce the electrical bill and also spread the awareness on use of solar energy for water heating, solar home lighting system, solar lantern, solar cookers, energy efficient smokeless. This would reduce wood consumption as well as smoke will reduce considerably, Gobar gas plant for cooking as well as for lighting, solar pumps through MNRE subsidy scheme, etc. Energy efficient LED bulbs were distributed to the poor people of the village to encourage the people to use energy efficient lighting fixtures.

School of Physical Chemical and Biological Sciences Department of Biotechnology Awareness Drive by DATRI Foundation on 16th Feb, 2018



A visit to Shristi Special Academy, Chennanahalli, Magadi, Bangalore Rural.

As a way of paying back to the society, we the Department of Biotechnology, School of Physical, Chemical and Biological Sciences, REVA University, had organized an outreach program to the **Shristi special academy**, a non-profit organisation that strives for the self-reliance and acceptance of special individuals. The academy is a day-school which is run by a private trust which focuses on caring children suffering from Down syndrome, Autism, Attention Deficient Hyperactivity syndrome, Cerebral palsy and multiple disorders. There are almost 170 students, within the age group 9 months to 40 years in the academy.

We have asked for their specific requirements and they had expressed a need for ceiling fans. As a part of our service, we donated 6 ceiling fans for the institution, by the monetary contribution of students and teachers.

50 students of UG and PG Biotechnology and a faculty Prof. Ramya. M had visited the institution on 27th of March 2018. The students had an orientation by Mr. Raju, Coordinator, SSA, on the origin and working of the academy followed by visit to different classrooms where the activity of these special students are monitored. Our students interacted with the special students and were overwhelmed by their response. The students are being trained in minor self-employment activities such as tailoring, bag making and artificial jewellery making.








REPORT ON COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM


