“Report on career development”

The School of Arts and Humanities, Reva University organised a career development workshop in creative writing on 11th January 2017 for the students of B.A. Journalism. A Mumbai based creative content creator/writer Rajiv Bose conducted a two hour session on “50 ways to improve creative writing and written communication”. The students were asked to build hypothetical situations of their choice and script imaginary experiences of the given situation. Students took upon this task and diligently came up with 1000-word articles. Bose then spoke about the different elements in creative writing.
