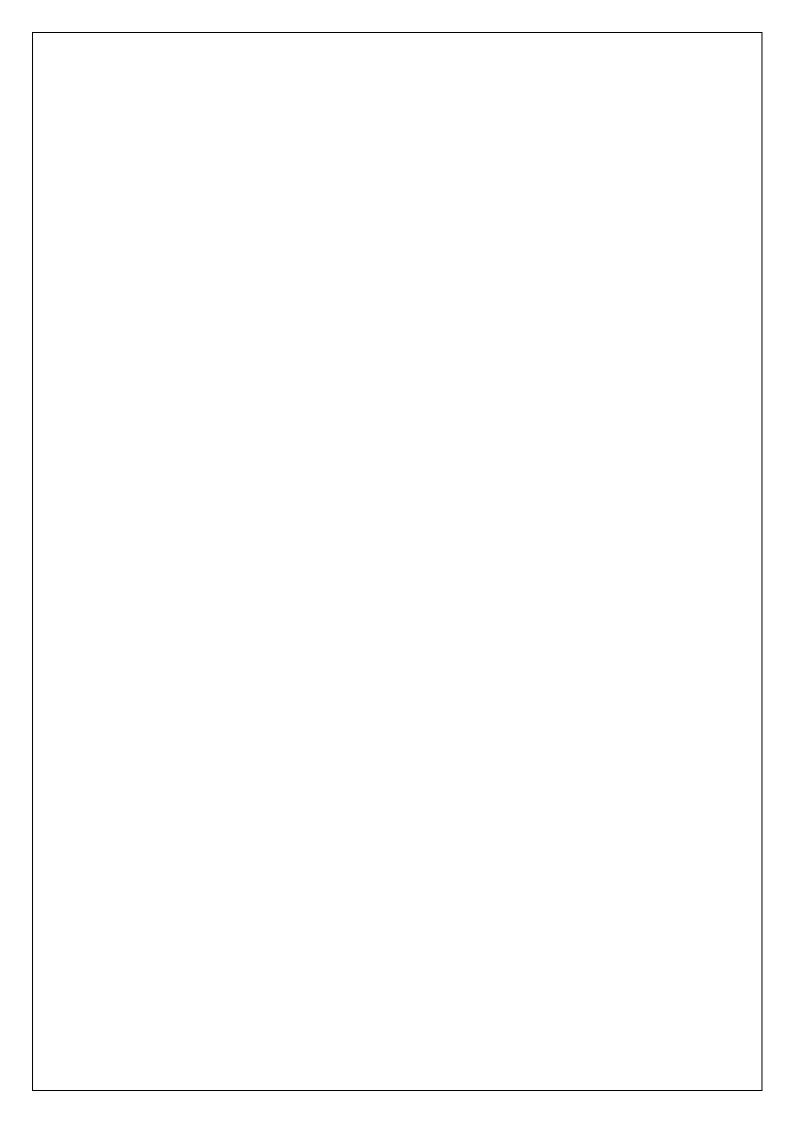


## SCHOOL OF ARTS AND HUMANITIES

"Report on career development"

The School of Arts and Humanities, Reva University organised a three hour session on "Counselling as an important therapy for mental health and its career prospects" on 11th February 2017 for students of B.A. English. The students had a three hour session with the Chennai-based Psychologist and student counsellor Rhine Dubey. During the session, Dubey spoke about the scope and need for counsellors, psychologists in India. She emphasised on the skills the students should develop to pursue the profession. She highlighted on developing verbal communication, qualities such as patience, care and understanding to become good counsellors. In the next two hours students witnessed video slides on how counselling is done for the teenagers and children. Dubey also reflected upon her personal learning experiences in the industry.
