Department of Biotechnology, REVA University, Bangalore, organized a special class for

CSIR-NET/LS as an inaugural address for the coaching classes starting from September 2018-

May 2019 in the weekends to train postgraduate students for CSIR (Council of Scientific and

Industrial Research) and equivalent exams for pursuing higher studies. The resource person for

the special class was Dr. Jyoti Bala, Chief Research Advisor at WREP-India, New Delhi,

India. 52 students of MSc Biotechnology attended the session.

Dr. Bala shared the present requirements for cracking competitive examinations in the field of

Life Sciences and how one should be ready to meet those requirements. She spoke about the

applications in the field of biological sciences based on which questions are framed for

competitive examinations. Dr. Bala interacted with almost all students in a one-to-one basis

trying to inculcate the competitive aptitude in them. She also mentioned that during preparation

for the national level exams as per the syllabus of CSIR, the students will be covering the

University curriculum as well. The overall session was interactive in terms of the involvement
