Why ESE?

Engineering Services Examination (ESE) is conducted every year by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) for recruitment to the Indian Engineering Services happens to be the most sought-after career for the engineering graduates in India.

Tough& Competitive: ESE is considered as one of the toughest examination in India due to the difficulty related to the examination and the selection procedure. Also there are less number of posts and more number of aspirants. Based on 2018 statistics, a total of 2, 50,000+ candidates applied for a total of 511 Vacancies in all branches and cadres, having competition ratio of 1:570.

Social Status: The candidates, who get selected for ESE, enjoy a very high respect and stature in the society. Candidates who are selected for ESE are appointed as Assistant Executive Engineer in various departments under central government for Group A and Group B posts.

Wide Options: The various services in which recruitment is made through ESE include Indian Railways, Central Engineering, Central Water Engineering, Border Roads Engineering, Indian Defence Service of Engineers, Indian Ordnance Factories, Central Power Engineering, Indian Naval Armament Service, Central Electrical & Mechanical Engineering, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering, Indian Telecommunication Service, Wireless Planning & Co-ordination Wing etc.

As you are well aware that GATE examination is a national level assessment setting the standard for engineering students who will be graded based on their technical gradient.

IIT/IISc : GATE score open doors for students to pursue an M.Tech study in the renowned institute such as the IITs or IISc.
