MINUTES

Preamble

The Vice Chancellor, REVA University and Chairperson of the REVA University Anti-Ragging Committee welcomed all the members for the meeting and explained that this meeting of the Anti-

Ragging Committee is convened following the complaint received from Anti-Ragging & Anti-Racial Abuse Helpline (ID 12354) on 20th February 2020 at 3 pm through Telephone call and followed by email received on the same day (complaint Ref. No. ARCC/ KA-6344).

In the email it is stated that "a BBA 3rd year student of REVA University – a victim - has complained that the victim has been mentally harassed by unknown students. According to the victim, the culprit is abused regularly, passing non sense comments, threaten him that they will kill him in the college, the victim is very much tensed about his life and is feeling like to do suicide." The message says to kindly look into the matter as soon as possible.

The Vice Chancellor explained the investigation status about the complaint and requested all the members to extend their co-operation to complete the investigation and also to further strengthen the activities of the Ant-ragging Squad and Anti-ragging Committee to take necessary measures so as to prevent ragging menace if it exists even in a small corner.

Details of the Investigation

- Soon after receipt of the Telephone call, both Vice Chancellor and the Registrar being the Chairperson and Member Secretary of the Anti-Ragging Committee respectively invited the Nodal Officer and the Members of the Anti-Ragging Squad and requested them to investigate and to find out the complainant and the culprits if any and make a way for further investigation to find out the truth and take necessary measures including punishment to the culprits if any.
- 2. The Vice Chancellor and the Registrar also informed the Director of the School of Commerce and Management Studies and requested to find out the complainant and the culprits if any, through the faculty members and other staff in the school.
- 3. Meanwhile the members of the Anti-ragging committee were also informed and the intimation to convene this meeting was sent on 22nd February 2020.
- 4. Further the Registrar sent a reply to the Anti-Ragging & Anti-Racial Abuse Helpline about the status of the investigation.
- 5. The Anti-ragging Squad members and as well as the Director and faculty members of the School of Commerce and Management Studies have made every effort to identify the complainant, but



- did not succeed as the complainant has not revealed his/her identity. In the absence of identity of the complainant, the Squad and School faculty members found it difficult to identify the culprits.
- 6. During the meeting, the members of the ARC further added that they also made their efforts to identify any such incidence happened on the campus, but did not succeed.
- 7. The ARC reviewed all the measures taken by the University to protect the interest of the students and safeguard the students against any menace of ragging, if any, in the campus. The Posters have been displayed prominently on Notice Boards of all Schools/Departments, hostels and other buildings as well as at places, where students normally gather and at places, known to be vulnerable to occurrences of ragging incidents to highlight the Provisions of Penal Law applicable to incidence of ragging and the provisions of these Regulations and also any other law for the time being in force to make the community at large and the students in particular aware of the dehumanizing effect of ragging of the institution towards those indulging in ragging. Also printed leaflet detailing to whom he/ she has to turn to for help and guidance for various purposes including addresses and telephone numbers, so as to enable the student to contact the concerned person including hostel wardens, Vice-Chancellor, all the members of the Anti-Ragging Squads and Committees and Police authorities at any time, if and when required, of the Anti-Ragging Helpline referred to in these Regulations,. In spite of this the University ARC and Squad Team have not received any complaint from any student about ragging.
- 8. The committee members felt that Anti-Ragging Squad and ARC members have sincerely tried to identify the complainant and the students who are harassing him/ her, but could not succeed due to lack of information from the complainant. In the absence of any details of the identification of the complainant and no such incidence of ragging either reported or witnessed by anybody in the University, the ARC felt that the incidence reported would be considered as false.
- 9. However, the ARC has further decided to request the UGC-Anti-Ragging & Anti-Racial Abuse Helpline team to provide the details if any received from the complainant student, and help us to identify the victim and the students who are harassing him / her and thereby take strict action to prevent any further incidence of harassing the victim and protect his/her interest so that he/she shall concentrate on the studies without any fear.

Dear Sir/Madam,

We have received a complaint of ragging from a student of REVA **INSTITUTE OF ENGG AND TECH BANGALORE**. The details are given below. You are requested to identify & counsel the victim so that she feels safe and knows that authorities are with her & action will be taken on her complaint. You are also requested not to disclose the identity of the victim.

"7.1 Action to be taken by the Head of the institution by the order of Hon. Supreme Court:

on receipt of any information concerningany reported incident of ragging, the Head of institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following, namely;

- v. Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- vi. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- x. Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences;
- xi. Extortion;
- xvii. Physical or psychological humiliation;

NOTE: Enquiry /Investigation /Disciplinary Committee reports etc. are not acceptable. As per UGC regulations only report of the Anti Ragging Committee is acceptable.

Minutes of Meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee against complaint Ref. No. ARCC/KA-5430 held on 06th May, 2019 in Board Room, Administrative Block, REVA University at 12:15 PM

This meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee was held on 06th May, 2019 at 12:15 PM in Board Room to conduct an investigation with regard to the complaint received on 02nd May, 2019 from Anti-Ragging & Anti-Racial Abuse Helpline (ID 12354)

Details of the investigation:

The three alleged students named Neha Ann John, D/o WG CDR P. J. Thomas, Minu Devaraj, D/o., Mr. Devaraj RS and Meenai, D/o., Mr. Sathya Choudhary are studying in 6th Semester of B.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering branch were summoned by the committee to appear before them. The alleged students appeared and denied all allegation made by the Complainant. They explained the internal differences that existed between the complainant and the alleged students. They stated that the complainant was friend of them and they were undertaking a mini project in the current semester as part of their curriculum study. They also stated that during this period there was some misunderstanding between the complainant and the alleged students which might have made the complainant to file this complaint.



Findings of the Committee:

- 1. The committee finds that there is no ragging involved in this matter.
- 2. In this matter the complainant with an intention of troubling the accused has raised an issue.
- 3. There is no evidence from the mentor of the accused or from the other classmates relating to the same.

As such the committee finds no fact in the complaint lodged by the complainant. However the committee advised the alleged students to maintain cordial and healthy relation among all the students and concentrate on academic growth.
