1. REVA University offers 5 B.Tech, 1 B.Arch, BA LLB, BBA LLB, B.Com, BBA, BCA, MCA, MBA, M.Com, M.A (Eng.), M.Tech (FT), M.Tech (PT) programs is their respective schools. There are 4725 students who are taking these programs. RU also offers doctoral programs in almost all the disciplines with a registration of 184 research scholars. Other than these RU programs, there are programs being offered by RITM (UG 2284, PG 280 students), RISM(1114 students), PU (841 students).

The overall strength of students in RU campus is 9341.

In order to reach this road map the infrastructure requirements (Class rooms, Labs., Seminar Halls, etc.) will be worked out separately.

Target of RU would be to accommodate about 20,000 students in the campus within next 5 years in various programs being offered in all schools.

- 2. All programs being offered at RU are assessed every year on the viability, relevance and demand in the market. If any programs is found to be not viable efforts will be made to re-structure the program to make it more industry relevant and market driven. Hence, during the traverse of the road map planned some of the programs may be closed / re-structured.
- 3. Faculty Development (HR Policies): RU understands the importance of faculty strength / quality to ensure quality of education. RU should be recognized as the destiny for students for qulity UG / PG education in all the disciplines of Engineering / Science / commerce / Management / Law and Architecture. Following is the road map to establish qualified, experienced & committed faculty base.

2015-16:

- Carry-out skill mapping based on the specialization requirement of the schools. Identify the gaps and carry-out training need analysis (TNA)
- Conduct series of in-house / external training programs on subject specific needs and also on pedagogy.
- Announce HR Policies: Normalize the salary structure to AICTE / UGC norms and eliminate discrepancies, if any
- Identify and recruit qualified researchers as TRAs



2016-17:

- Identify & Recruit qualified &specialized faculty based on the need of schools to meet the workload
- Ensure compliance to cadre ratio and staff-student ratio as prescribed by UGC
- Encourage empowerment of faculty for qualification up-gradation / skill development
- Schemes for collaborative / funded research / consultancy projects for faculty
- Implement Performance based appraisal scheme (PBAS) for the faculty
 Link compensation / package of salary to the performance.
- Providing computers to each faculty to enable the completely automated campus.

2017-18

- Atleast 50% of the faculty with Ph.D qualification
- Ensure average age of experience to 5 Yrs.
- Mandatory involvement faculty in research and publication of papers / articles in indexed / high impact factor journals / conferences
- Staff welfare schemes

2018-19

- Fully complied faculty base for RU
 - Qualified , Experienced , specialized who are committed to the vision of RU
 - o Realization of Vision of RU through the committed missions

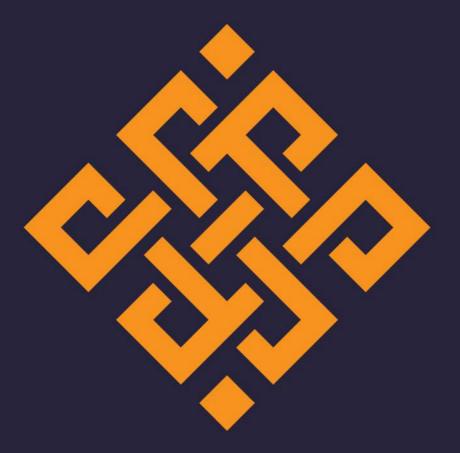
