Prologue

REVA University) is committed to the pursuit of excellence in research and aims to achieve international recognition through interdepartmental and inter-institutional collaborative research programmes across the spectrum of Engineering and Technology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biotechnology, Management Sciences, Architecture, Performing Arts as well as Social Sciences. REVA University shall ensure that research in all fields that include trans and multidisciplinary types grows exponentially, keeping the ethical norms and research standards intact.

Objectives

The primary objective of the proposed incentive scheme is to motivate all the faculty members / scholars of our University to undertake quality research, consultancy and other research related activities.

The scope of the scheme envisages in particular,

- To motivate faculty members to concentrate on research related activities in addition to the teaching so as to publish articles in reputed refereed international journals and conferences.
- To pursue efforts to write books, monographs for publication by International and National publishers of repute.
- To evince interest among the members of faculty so that they take efforts to establish collaborative research projects with their counterparts in reputed Indian/Foreign Universities.
- To encourage the faculty to submit project proposals and secure funded research projects from various funding agencies in India and Abroad.
- To undertake consultancy projects sponsored by both the Government and Private Industrial and other organizations.
- To encourage creativity in the minds of faculty, so that they make original contributions by way of products, concepts etc. and obtain patents.

Reimbursement will be given on submission of all the bills (Conference Registration fee payment receipt, Travel Tickets, other Bills etc. for the amount claimed. The faculty member can apply for the above mentioned incentive once the published paper is indexed in Scopus/WOS database.

International **

- Economy air fare (to & fro) will be given
- 50% conference registration fees will be reimbursed.
- On Duty and Daily Allowance will be given only for the conference dates.
- Financial Support Claim can be made once in two years by a faculty member.
- One of the faculty member (author) of the paper can seek reimbursement only if he/she is a first author, provided no other agency had given financial help for the same. A faculty is not eligible for reimbursement, for just chairing a session or attending the conference.
- Faculty members can apply for various travel fellowships sponsored by various government funding agencies.
- Maximum of 10% of the faculty of each school on first cum fist basis (for different conferences) can avail from each school per year.
 Conference must be of high repute only.

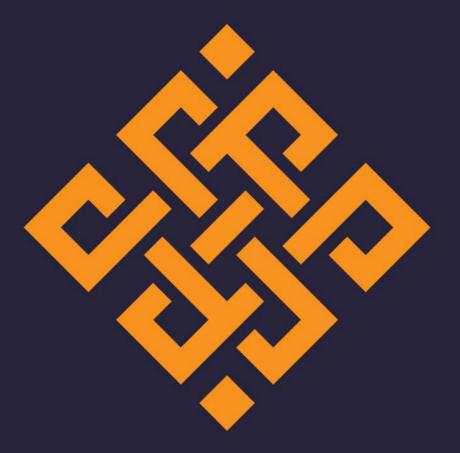
