
13. Seminars / Conferences / Workshops organized by the Schools:

14. Other Event (s) Organized by various Schools:


All the Schools have organized variety of events to inculcate different skills among students and to develop their overall personality. The students are given opportunities to participate in these events.


15. Seminars / Conferences / Workshops / Events Participated by the Faculty Members


16. Presentation of Papers in Seminars / Conferences by the Faculty Members


15. Seminars, Conferences, Workshops organized by the Schools:


17. Other Events Organized by various Schools:

18. Seminars, Conferences, Workshops, events Participated by the Faculty Members






15. Seminars, Conferences, Workshops organized by the Schools

All the Schools have organized variety of events to inculcate different skills among students and to develop their overall personality. The students are given opportunities to participate in these events.




18. Seminars, Conferences, Workshops, events Participated by the Faculty Members

19. Presentation of Research Papers in Seminars / Conferences by the Faculty Members



We, as an educating community, faced challenging situations in the last 18 months, and I am pleased to know despite a pandemic, and numerous other difficulties, REVA University accomplished many milestones.

In fact, I consider the pandemic a positive challenge, as it gave us an opportunity to discover our strengths and

I look forward to REVA benchmarking many new milestones in the coming year.






