NIRAMAI, are developing a novel software to detect breast cancer at a much earlier stage than traditional methods or self-examination. The core technology of solution is an artificial intelligence led diagnostic platform that uses patented thermal image processing and machine learning algorithms for reliable and accurate breast cancer screening.

Around fifteen people got benefited from the screening in the Camp.

Venue: Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Hall, Science Block, REVA University


**Date:** 8<sup>th</sup> June 2018



# Special Lecture Series on "Gender Studies"

The School of Arts and Humanities of REVA University has always played host to a plethora of activities, workshops and lectures by experts that tease the creative and intellectual faculties of its students. The school has held various literary activities throughout its glorious years and has had international delegates visit the campus to enlighten its students on various literary and pressing socio-political issues that is often the need of the hour. The School of Arts and Humanities had recently organized a weeklong special lecture series on the raging issue of Gender, that ran from 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 to 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2019. The resource persons of the special lecture series were Dr. Elizabeth Joy Birmingham (Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities) and Dr. Anne Lorene Chambers (Chair, Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities) from Lakehead University, Canada, with whom REVA University has an academic collaboration.

Lakehead University, which has two campuses at Thunder Bay and Orillia, offers a wide range of student oriented undergraduate and graduate programs. The University boasts of a multicultural population, with over 500,000 international students calling it their home.

The lecture series was initiated by the delegates with a glimpse into the history of Canada and the evolution of its criminal and civil laws. The students were enlightened about various court cases that changed the course of history, like the case of O.J. Simpson v/s the State. The resource persons emphasised on the role of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms in governing the lives of the citizens and ensuring equality amongst them. The lecture took its course towards highlighting the position of women in the 20<sup>th</sup> century and their gradual progress towards emancipation. The idea about various social evils like those of domestic violence and sexual abuse struck a similar chord with the marginalised status of women in India. By extrapolating on the issues of rape, abortion and property rights, the speakers stressed on the need for a further amendment in the laws that would work towards the betterment of the condition of women in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

The Director of the School of Arts and Humanities, Dr. Payel Dutta Chowdhury, provided an insight into the Indian scenario of violence and abuse which enabled the students to point out the parallels that exist between India and Canada, along with the shared colonial history. This connection, thus, provided a holistic perspective to the lecture series giving the students an international exposure.




About 150 participants comprising of students, from various semesters were present. Students expressed their gratitude in exposing them to such talk which gives them a legal awareness as they groom as corporates.


















#### "AWARENESS ON MOST PREVALENT CANCERS IN WOMEN"

The School of Electrical and Electronics Engineering had organized a Social Outreach Program at Chikkasanne, Anneshwara Grama Panchayat, Devanahalli Taluk, Bangalore on **06/11/2019**, from 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, & 7<sup>th</sup> semester students.

About 41 students actively participated in the awareness program. During this program, the students have visited all the houses in the village to conduct door to door survey and collected the energy details from each house:

The students explained about the energy conservation measures that can be adopted to reduce the electrical bill and also spread the awareness on use of solar energy for water heating, solar home lighting system, solar lantern, solar cookers, energy efficient smokeless. This would reduce wood consumption as well as smoke will reduce considerably, Gobar gas plant for cooking as well as for lighting, solar pumps through MNRE subsidy scheme, etc. Energy efficient LED bulbs were distributed to the poor people of the village to encourage the people to use energy efficient lighting fixtures. The students performed a drama which was scripted to promote the use of energy efficient equipment and renewable energy system to reduce the environmental pollution.

The Panchayat president and all the villagers have appreciated the efforts of the students to create the awareness program for the villagers.

#### **Guest Lecture Series on Power, Gender and Language**

The School of Arts and Humanities of REVA University has always played host to a plethora of activities, workshops and lectures by experts that stimulate the creative and intellectual faculties of its students. The School has held various literary activities throughout its glorious years and has had international delegates visit the campus to enlighten the students on various literary and pressing socio-political issues that are often the need of the hour. The School of Arts and Humanities organised a week long special lecture series on the raging issue of **Power**, **Gender and Language** that ran from 16<sup>th</sup> September 2019 to 20<sup>th</sup>September 2019. The resource person for the special lecture series was **Dr. Elizabeth Joy Birmingham (Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities) from Lakehead University, Canada,** with whom REVA University has an academic collaboration. Lakehead University, which has two campuses at Thunderbay and Orillia, offers a wide range of student oriented undergraduate and graduate programs. The University boasts of a multicultural population, with over 500,000 international students calling it their home.

The lecture series was initiated by the resource person by dividing the students of MA English I and III semester students into five different groups randomly. The students were enlightened about various gender stereotypes men and women have that which affect their health which are unique to each gender. Males for example are perceived to be greater risk takers as a whole in our society than that of females.

Students shared their views and discussed on how gender and power relations continue to be at odds with each other in the post-millennium era. They critically reviewed how we still live in a male dominated society where patriarchal power still holds the 'key' to the door (s) and windows of 'freedom', self-identity and expression. They critically engaged with this statement drawing on key writers in the field of religion, ethnicity and gender relations. The most accepted

definition for the term patriarchy is the social structure of society based on the father having primary responsibility for the welfare of and authority over their families.

Students did a lot of activities with respect to power, gender and sexuality. Overall the feedback from the students as well as from the eminent professor was extremely good. The Lecture series provided a holistic perspective on gender identity and recognition of the perceived social gender attributed to a person.





With this saying Dr. Priyanka Reddy case: THE BRUTAL RAPE AND MURDER THAT LEFT ENTIRE NATION IN SHOCK...

Dr. Priyanka Reddy, a veterinary doctor from Shamshabad in Hyderabad was found dead with her body partially burnt under Chatanpalli Bridge in Shadnagar on Thursday morning. She was working as a doctor in Kolluru village. The incident happened on 27<sup>th</sup> November night. She was raped, smothered and then burnt by four men who are said to be hailing from Narayanpet. How anyone could subject another human being to such terrible, unprovoked violence is beyond imagination.

Such incidents remind us to be more cautious and careful. Seeking help in case of emergency will most probably become easier in **India as the government has launched an integrated support system with a single emergency number 112** to address different kinds of emergencies for the citizens. The emergency number is launched under the Emergency Response Support System (ERSS) and has been designed by the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC). ERSS service will eliminate the need for people to remember multiple helpline numbers and remember just one emergency number 112 for nay kind of emergencies. The integrated number will connect to Police, Fire, Health and other helplines through an Emergency Response Centre in the State. **The students were told to install the APP-112 in the class itself.**






# Report of "COVID 19 and Stress Management" College students' mental health during pandemic era

The Department of Biotechnology, School of Applied Sciences organized a Guest talk on "Kinesin Spindle Protein: An anti-cancer Target" on 11/10/2022. The resource person for the talk was Dr. Rajasekhar Karpoormath, Associate Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Chemistry, School of Health Sciences, University of Kwazulu-Natal, Durban, South Africa. He has more than two decades of experience in teaching and Research. His Main area of Research is Target based drug design and synthesis of small molecules as potential anticancer and antimicrobial agents. Till date he has published 149 papers, two book chapters and two patents, just in a span of 7 years (2014-2021) in international journals. Over the years he has successfully secured several national and institutional grants worth over 6.5 million Rand (500,000 USD), He established a well-equipped Drug Discovery Laboratory. He has successfully graduated 22 postgraduate students (17 Ph.Ds. and 15 Masters) since 2014. He is one of the top researchers at UKZN and was the recipient of several awards in recognition of his achievements. The talk was conducted offline in Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam seminar Hall, SoAS block. 78 postgraduate students from Biotechnology and B.Sc Bioinformatics attended the session.

Dr. Rajasekhar Karpoormath began his presentation by discussing the development of innovative medications through in silico research. Sinu Joseph was invited as the guest speaker, she is a menstrual educator, an author, a threetime TEDx speaker and one of the pioneers of the menstrual health movement in India. Her work on menstruation has been unique in its efforts of unearthing the ancient science behind native menstrual practices and bringing forth a narrative which is the Bharatiya perspective on menstruation, The resource person spoke about the topic by explaining the logic behind the menstrual practices followed across India in parlance with Indian tradition/Philosophy/yogic language and modern science. The resource person has travelled across both South India and North India and interacted with young girls on menstruation. It was observed that similar menstrual practices were taught by grandmothers of all generations for several hundred years. Then it was realized by her that these practices are not superstitious but a whole system of knowledge. In terms of yogic writing/languages, Naadi's carry Prana and all Naadi meet at specific places called Chakra in our human body. Prana helps to perceive people when we talk/interact with each other/group. Though Prana cannot be seen, it can be experienced when we speak, when we hear from others. This is important in explaining the reasons for restrictions during menstrual period. After this, interactive Q and A session was conducted on menstrual seclusion and related areas.
