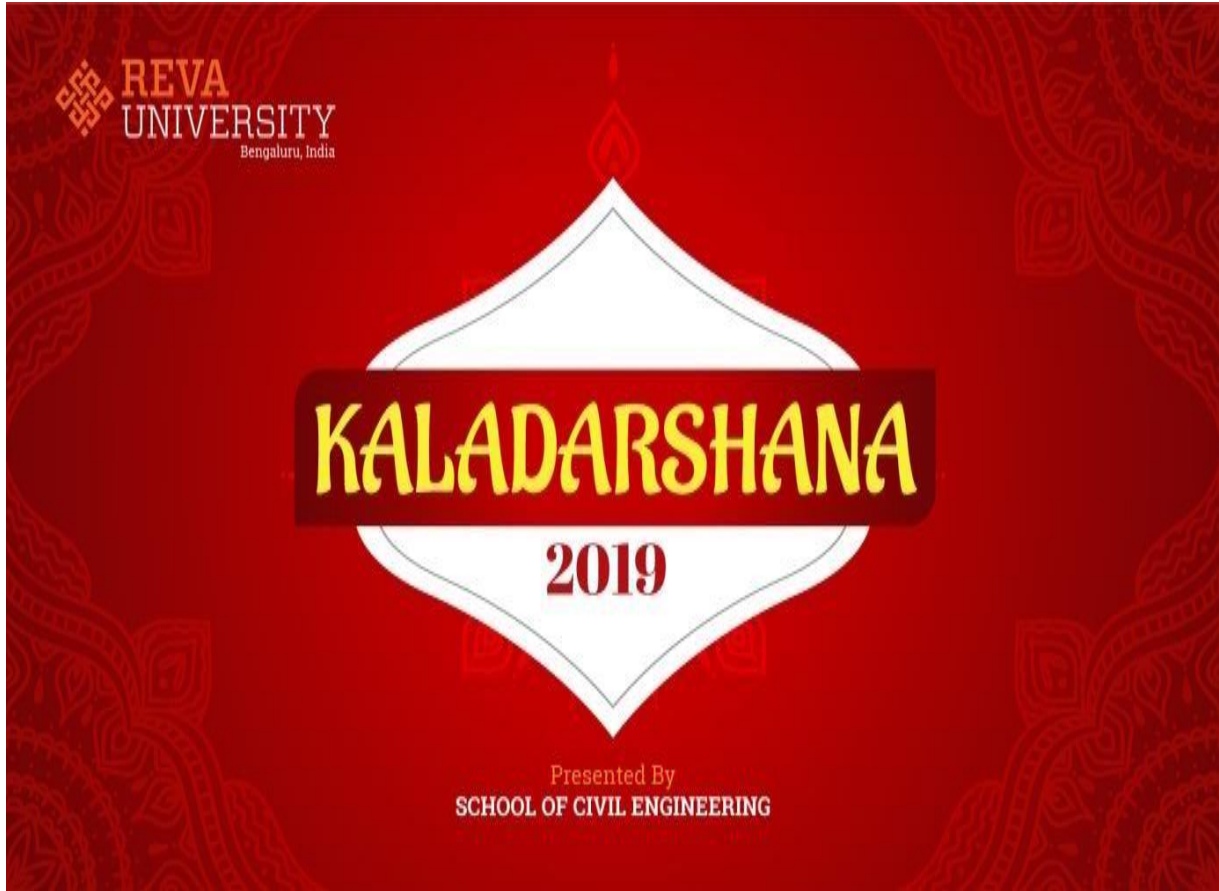
The first programme was a fusion musical medley, where the students filled with flavours of music with their choice of songs, and it was a wonderful start to the event.

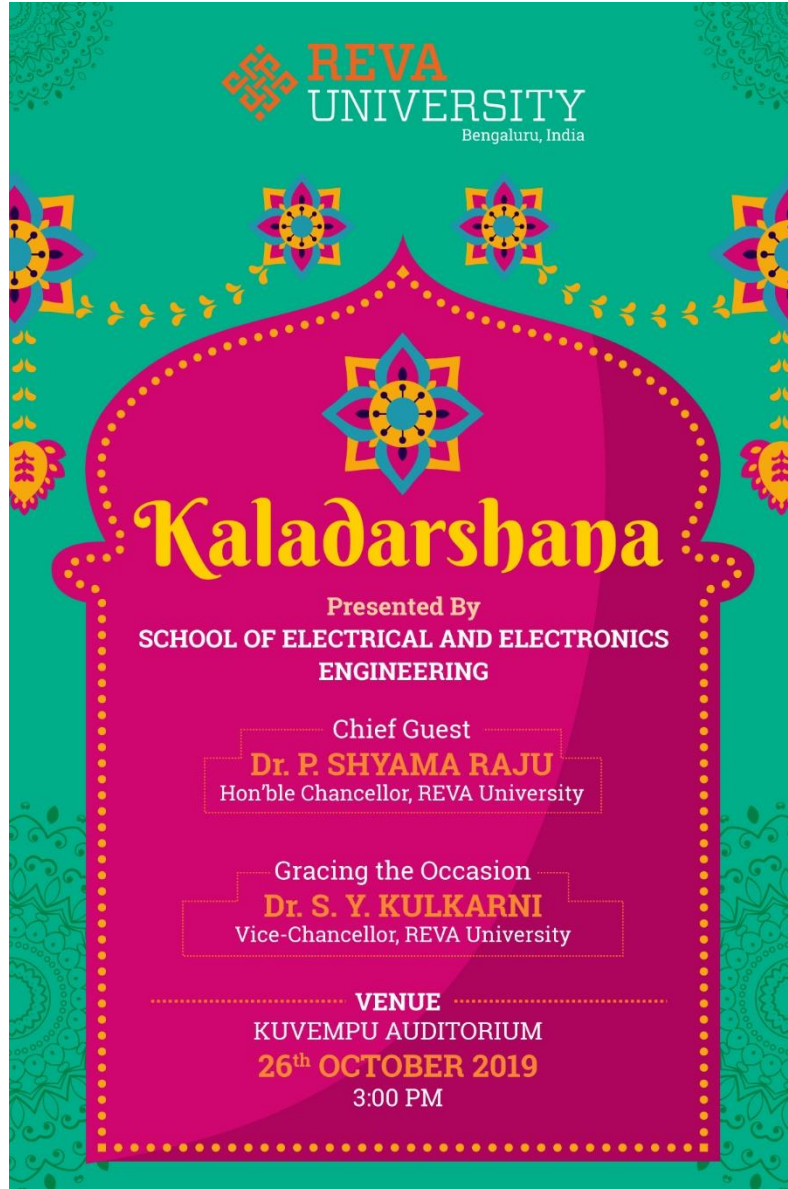

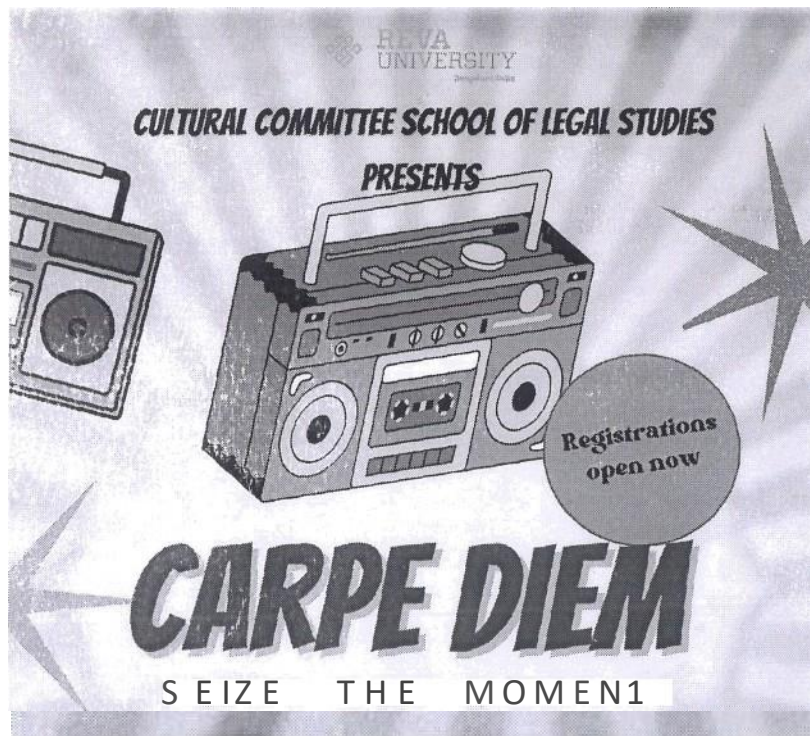


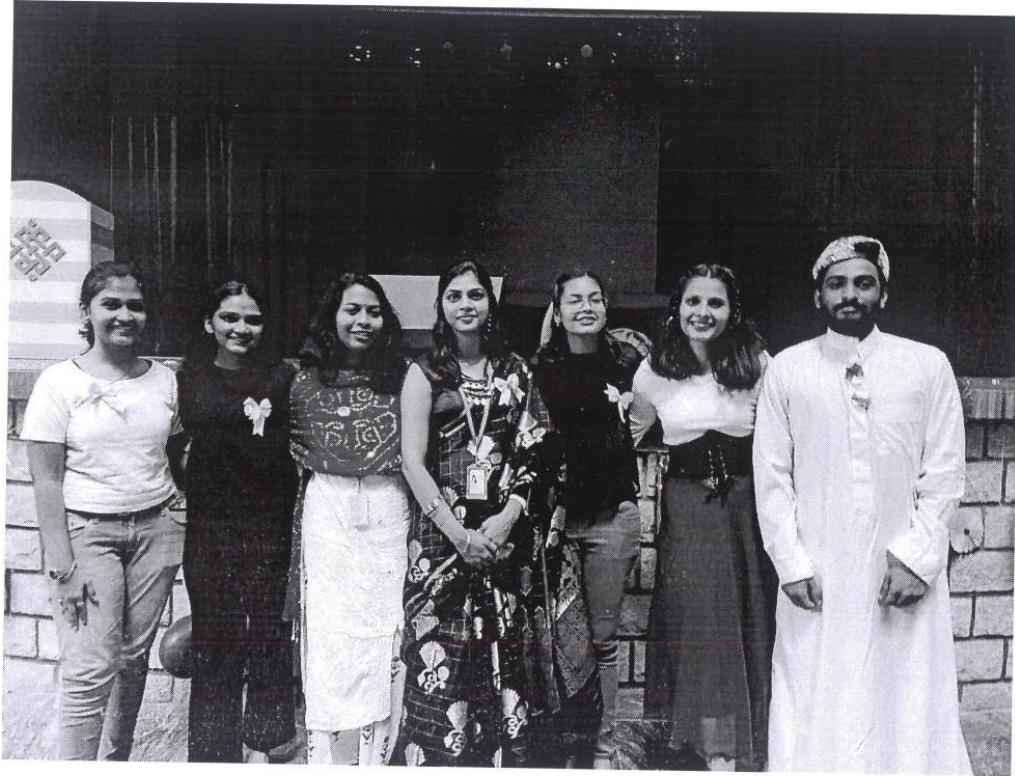


Kala Darshana - School of Legal Studies
