REVA University celebrates, the birth anniversary of Saint and Poet KANAKA DASA, one of the greatest social reformers of Karnataka and who is equally noted for his musical compositions

The 15th century revolutionary poet Kanakadasa advocated equality and defied caste system. He generally worships Lord Vishnu, but Saint Kanakadasa questioned Vishnu. From a young age Kanakadasa had to bear the brunt of the notorious caste system and untouchability and he fought against the evil through his poems, which exposed the futility of external rituals and stressed the need for promoting of moral values in life.

Poems of Kanakadasa dealt with every aspect of life and he was highly critical of the caste system. In one such poem, Ramadhanyacharite, he suggests that the difference between the higher and lower castes is similar to the difference between rice and millet. Rice is used by high caste people and for religious rituals. Millet is the staple food of the poor. But Millet is much higher in status in the eyes of God (Lord Ram). Great Bhakti poet, philosopher, musician, social reformer, composer are some of the titles often associated with Kanakadasa. A society like ours need the message and teachings of the social reformer Sri Kanaka Dasaru. Nearly 150 students and faculty have participated in the birthday celebrations.


Teacher's Day-2019
